 - 1. The Love & Justice of God, Free Will, and Consequences [Hebrews 12:1-13]
 - 2. Why would teachers be moved into a corner?
 - 3. Teachers
 - a. Refreshing cups of water
 - b. Point my arrows in the right direction
 - c. When they talk, it sounds (feels) like the Lord; prophetic
 - B. Isaiah 50:4
 - 1. “The Tongue of the Learned”
 - a. Describing Jesus
 - b. In Christ, Believers also have the Tongue of the Learned
[Ro 8:17; 1 John 4:17]
 - 2. “to Hear as the Learned”
 - a. Daily Quiet Time
 - b. Listen with a heart to Obey; ‘be the Head and not the Tail’ [Deu 28:13]
 - C. Journeying Together towards Heaven; Living the Abiding Life Every day
[Ps 84:5-7; John 15:1-17]

 - 1. What does it say? (read the Bible)
 - 2. What does it mean? (exegesis; content + context = meaning)
 - B. Heart
 - 3. What is the Spirit of the Lord saying to me? (what “grabs” my heart?)
 - C. Hands
 - 4. What is God asking me to do? (my act of obedience)
