I. The Favor of God [Luke 1:24-30]

A. Defined

- 1. God's favor refers to <u>His</u> gracious disposition toward people—<u>His</u> willingness to bless, help, empower, protect, and give access to His presence. It is not something earned by human effort but given through <u>His</u> grace.
- 2. It is:
 - a. Immediate: "now!" [Titus 2:11]
 - b. Freely given by grace [Eph 2:7-10; Ro 8:32]
 - c. Empowering, Spirit-filled [Acts 1:8; 2:17-18]
 - d. Life-changing: Salvation + Transformation [2 Cor 5:18; Ro 12:1-2]
 - e. Opportunity-based: a divine moment that must be seized [Acts 2:38-39]

B. Highly Favored

- 1. to pursue with grace; surround with favor; to honor with blessings
- 2. Jews anticipated Messiah to be born via Davidic line [Micah 5:2], no emphasis on the mother of Messiah. The humility of Mary [Luke 1:48; 2:24]
- 3. Everyone IN CHRIST [Eph 1:6]

C. Favored

- 1. The first formal message of Jesus [Luke 4:16-21]
- 2. that most blessed time when Salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound [2 Cor 6:2; Eph 2:7-10]
- 3. Everyone IN CHRIST [Ro 3:24; John 1:16-17; Acts 4:33]
- D. NOTE: not negated because of illness [2 Cor 12:9]
- II. "How can this be?" [Luke 1:31-37]
 - A. Mary chosen to be the Mother of Jesus Christ [Jer 1:5; 2 Tim 1:9]
 - B. The Immanuel Prophecy [Isa 7:14]
 - C. Nothing is Impossible with God [Jer 32:17]
- III. Receive and Believe [Luke 1:38]
 - A. I am a Child of God; I Serve the Lord [John 1:12-13; Ro 8:14-17; Rev 4:11]
 - B. Let it be to me according to Your Word: rhema, spoken Word [Matt 4:4]
 - C. Enjoying the Favor of God and being Ready to Hear [Prov 3:1-6; 2 Pe 1:2-4]
